

ISS-DDD

INTENSIVE STABILIZATION SERVICES –
DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

WHO:

- Children and youth 2-20 years old,
- Residing in King County,
- With their parent or guardian;
- And have a diagnosed disability.

WHAT:

Services for up to 90 days which can include –

- Safety Planning
- Creation of an FBA/PBSP
- Parent Coaching
- Limited behavior intervention
- Education advocacy
- Linking to additional community-based resources

WHY:

Prevent or Reduce –

- High-risk behaviors resulting in a crisis
- Inpatient hospitalization and emergency services
- Involvement in the juvenile justice system

Promote or Increase –

- Effective use of positive behavior supports and crisis management techniques
- Community capacity to support children and youth with I/DD and their families

ISS-DD TEAM INCLUDES:

Child & Family Intervention Specialist · Parent Partner · Behavioral Technician

HOW TO ACCESS:

DDA enrolled youth:

- Family or team should request through Case Manager
- Case Manager completes referral form and submits to DDA designee with signed consent
- DDA designee submits to ISS-DD team for enrollment

Non-DDA enrolled youth:

- Family should contact the King County Crisis Line and request CCORS services
 - 206-461-3222
- CCORS team will do initial intake with the family
- If youth is determined to have an identified disability, an internal referral to ISS-DD and/or consult with the ISS-DD team will occur on behalf of the family.
