1. Name of the study: Meeting the Need: Increasing Access to Applied Behavior Analysis Services in Washington State
2. Principle Investigator: Dr. Katherine Bateman
3. Research institute or organization: University of Washington
4. Basic description of the study: This study seeks to provide online, state-of-the-art Applied Behavior Analysis services to families of children with Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities. Intervention is 16 weeks, May-August.
5. Clear description of desired participants (e.g. age, gender, diagnosis, language/cultural group, etc.): Parents of children diagnosed with Intellectual or Developmental Disabilities ages 1.5- 8 years of age. If autism, child cannot currently be accessing ABA services (waitlists okay). Intervention is offered in English. Access to internet and device to run Zoom technology is also needed.
6. Detailed description of participants' commitment, activities, and reimbursement: Participants will commit to 16 weeks of weekly, 1 hour parent coaching sessions starting in May. Sessions will occur on Wednesday evenings from 7-8 pm. These sessions can be attended at home as they are offered online through Zoom technology.
