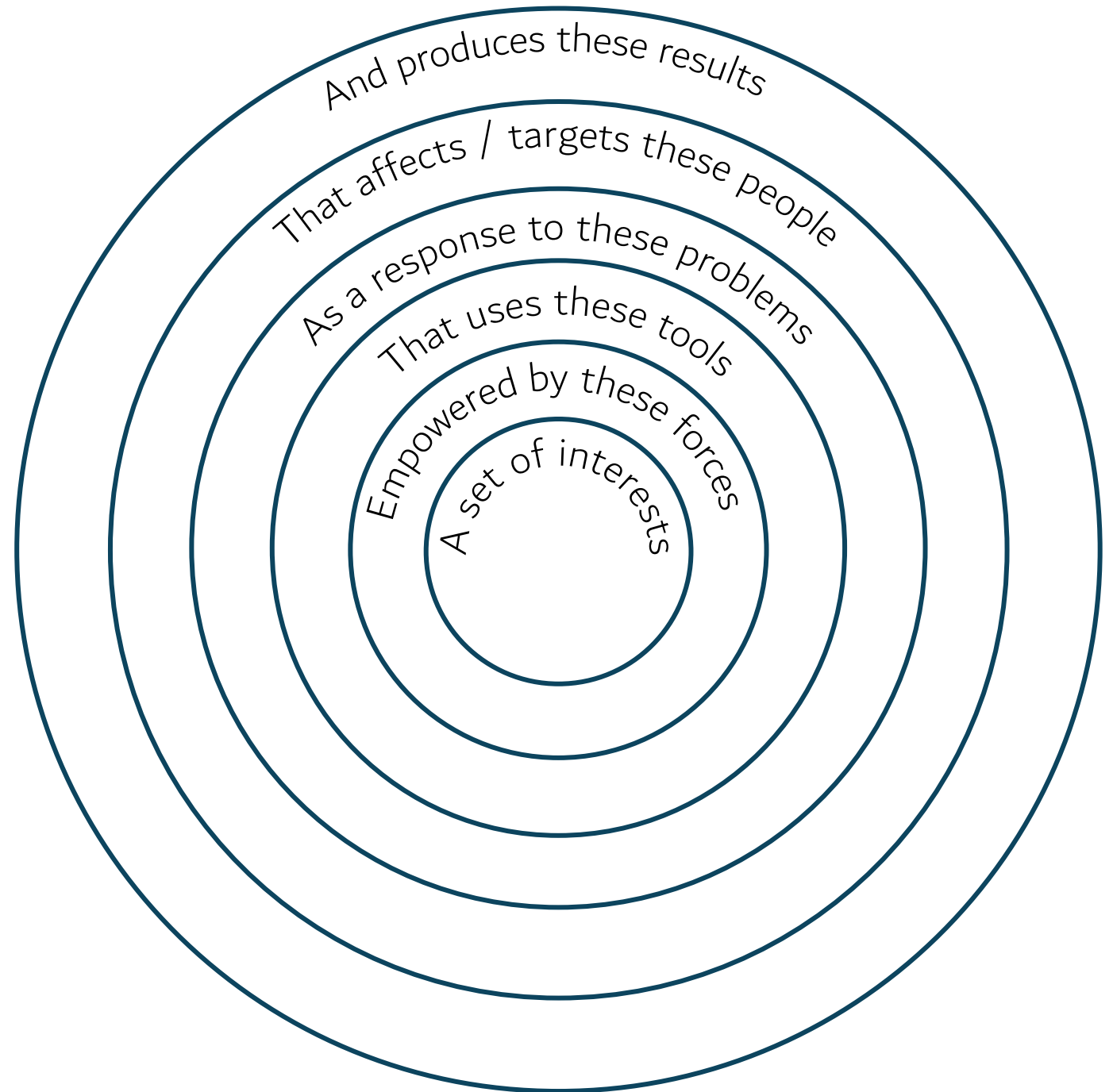

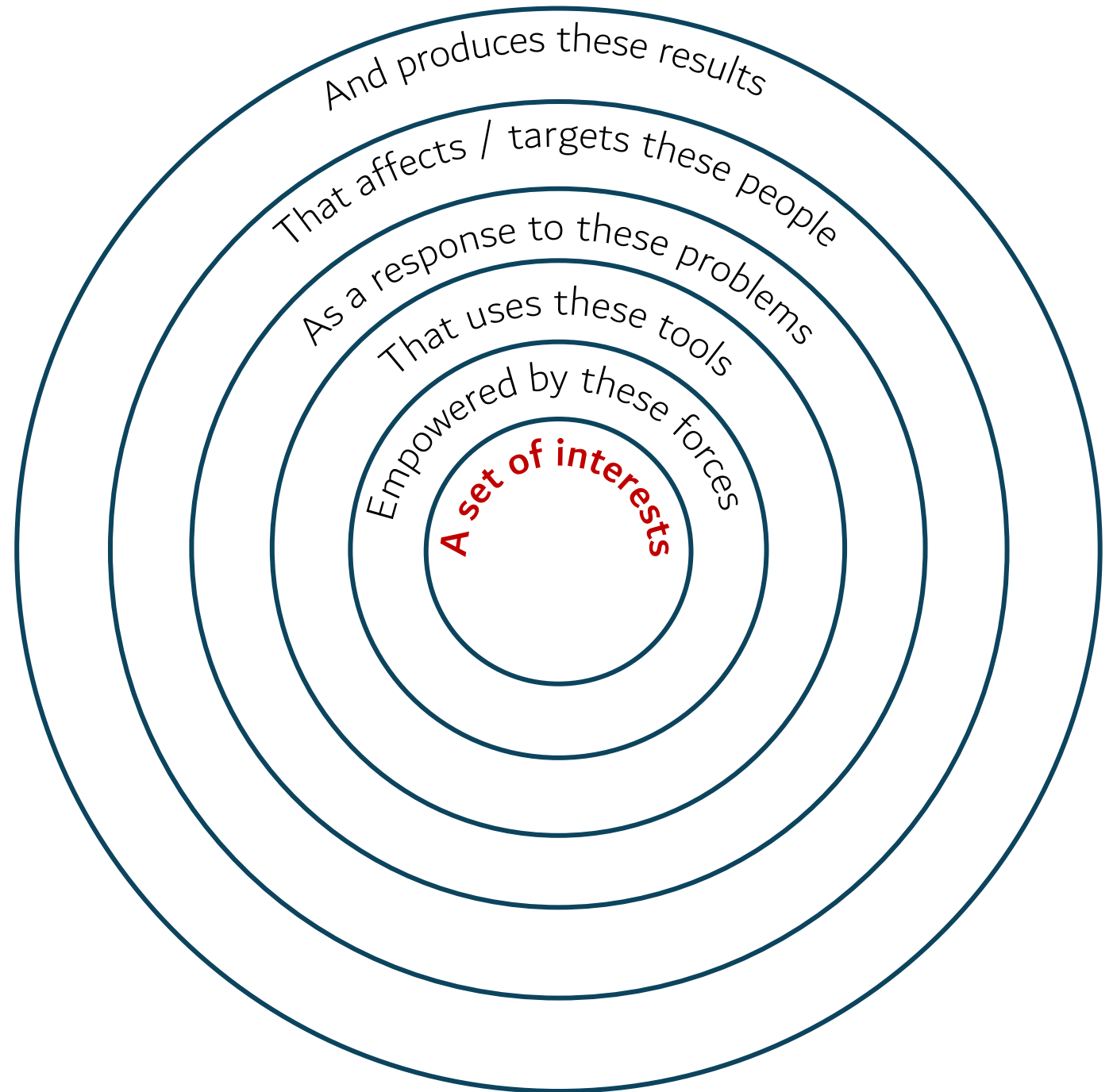

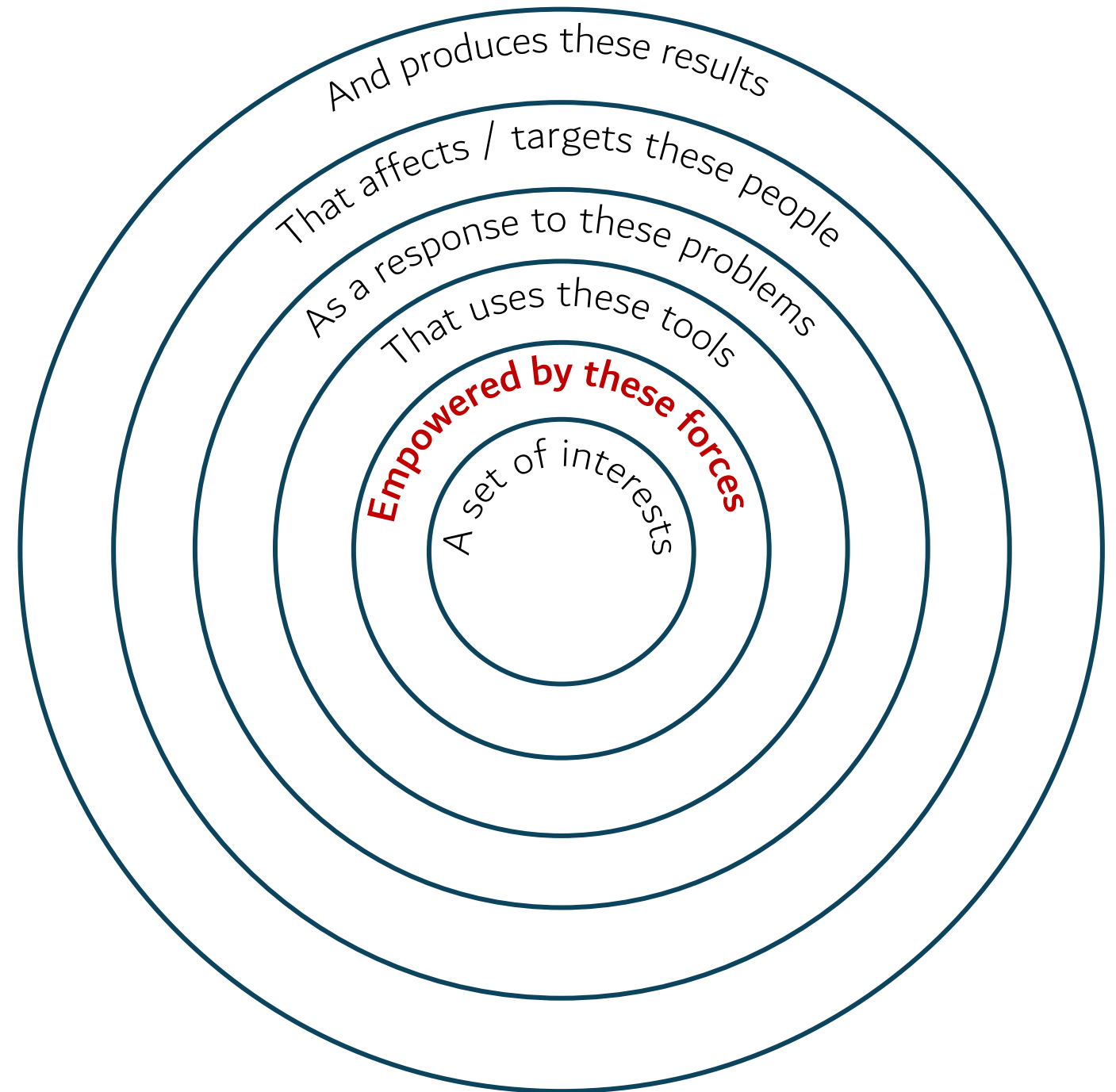

# Exclusion in schools is **a set of interests**



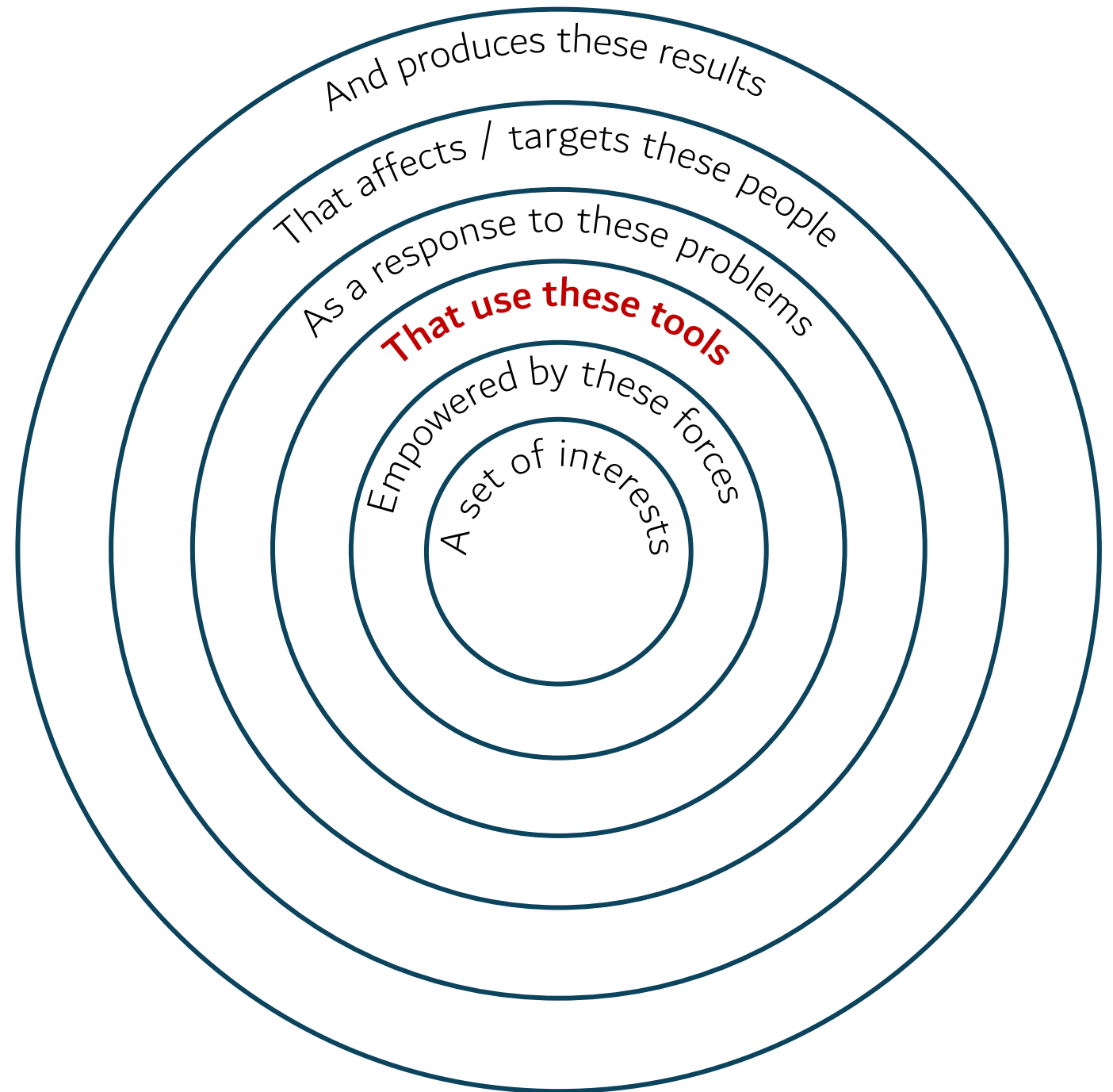
**Prompt:** Who influences or controls the practices and policies that can exclude children?

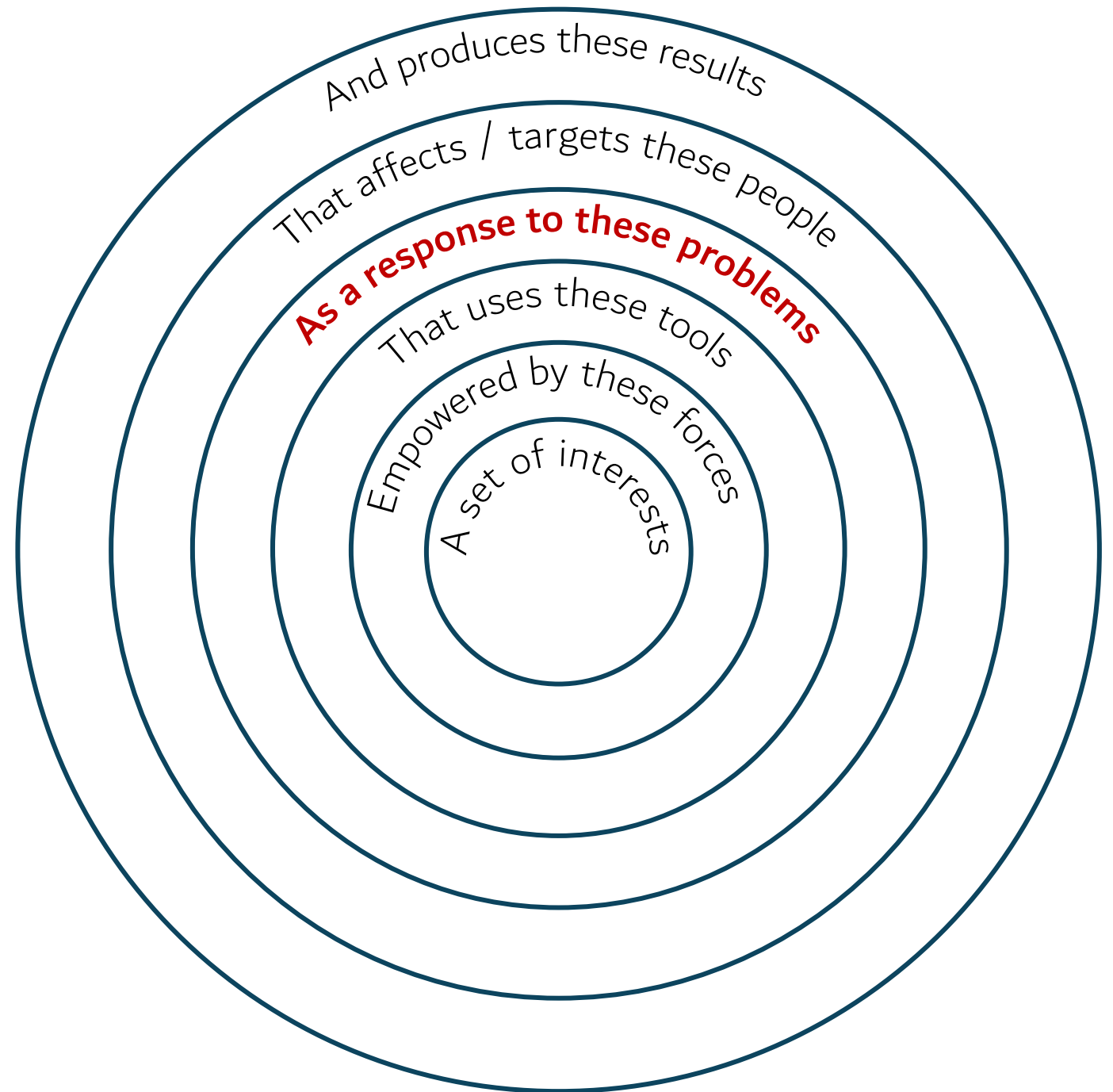
**Prompt:** What attitudes or beliefs influence how people think about disability, accessibility, and belonging?

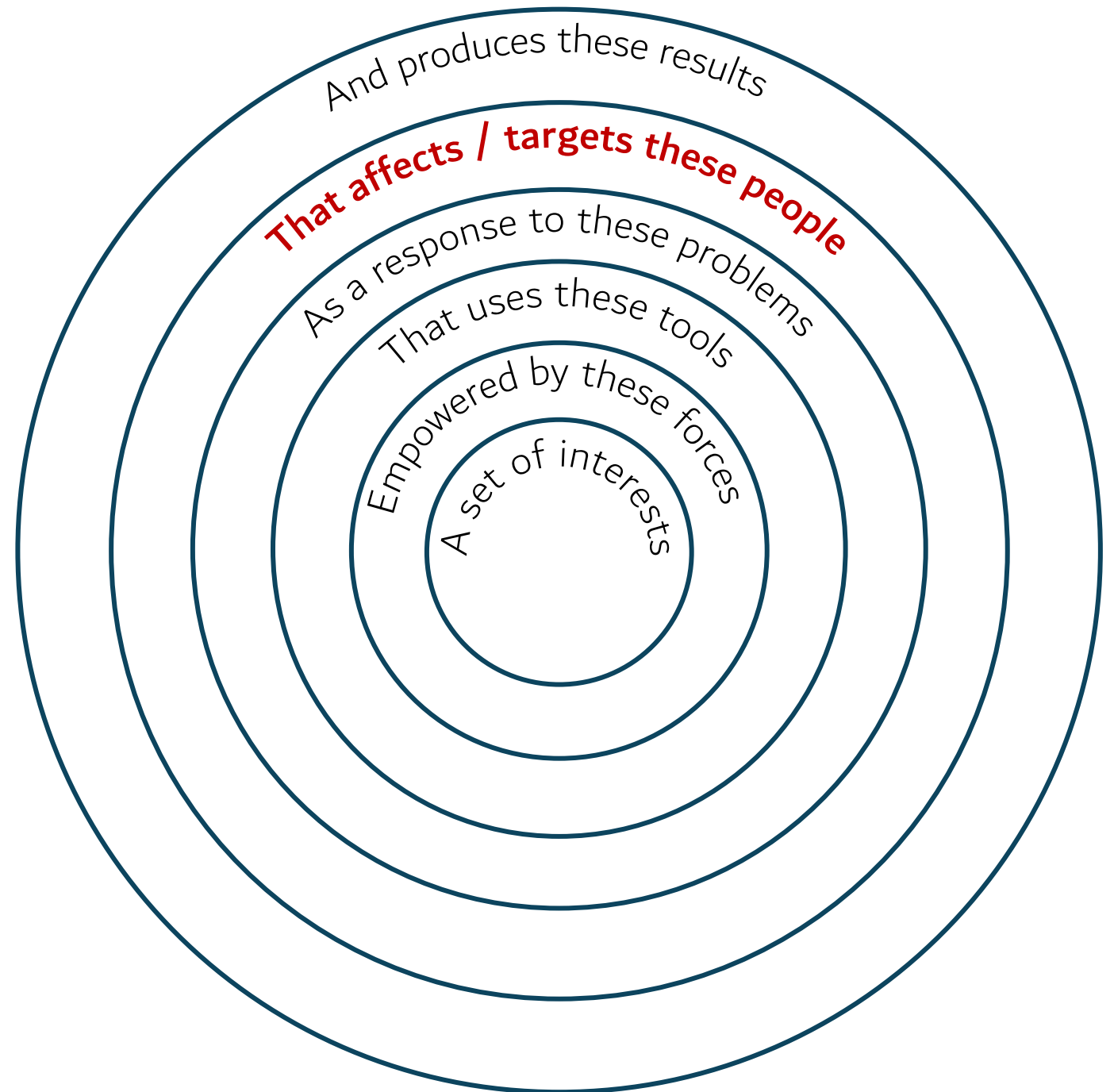

reacting to? In fear of?

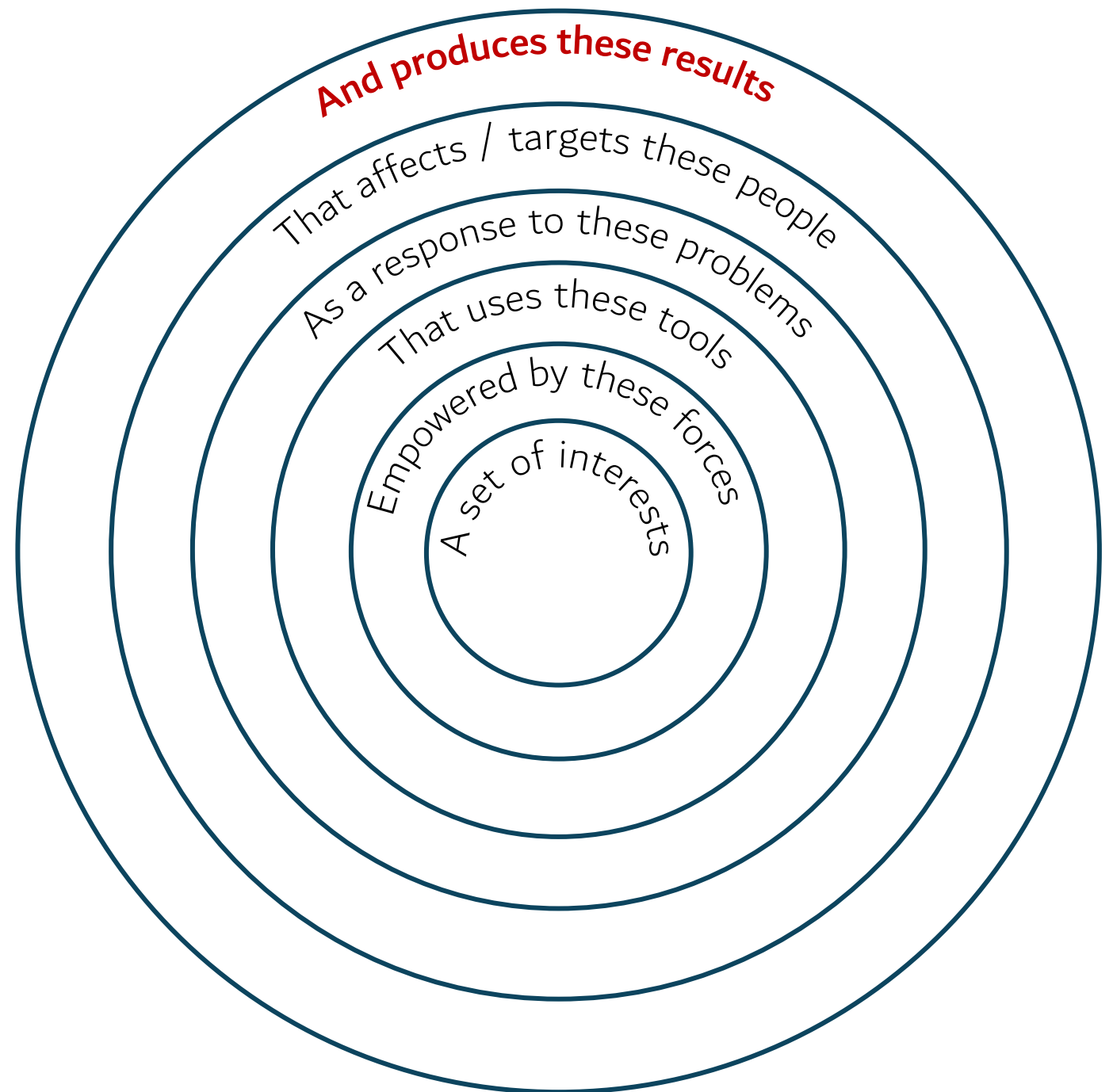
Exclusion in schools is a set of interests empowered by these forces that use these tools as a response to these problems **that affects/targets these people**



**Prompt:** Who feels the effects of exclusionary practices?



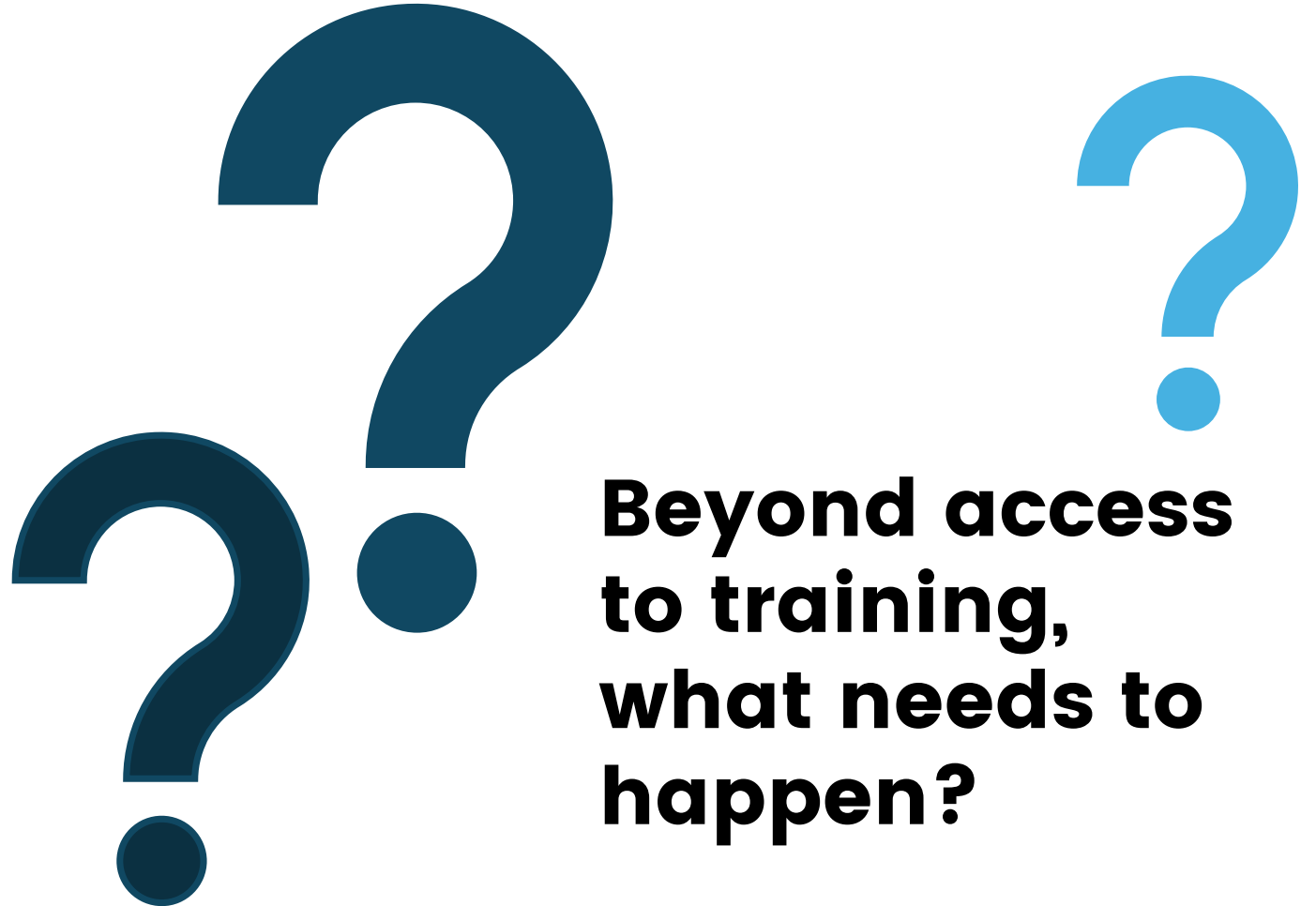
Exclusion in schools is a set of interests empowered by these forces that use these tools as a response to these problems that affects/targets these people **and produces these results**
