Learning Pod Pricing

Elementary grades K – 5 & Middle School grades 6 – 8

A Learning Pod is a small group that consists of 4 to 6 students and 1 Pod Leader in a home setting. Pod Leaders guide and assist students with existing remote online learning. Additionally, our Learning Pods claim afternoons as POD TIME for enrichment activities done as a group: Literacy in the form of Read Alouds, Readers' Theater and Writers' Workshop. PM POD TIME is time to gather as a group, have fun, learn and socialize while still maintaining a learning environment. Our Learning Pod model is designed to support working parents. One parent must be onsite during hosting of the Pod. Families share Pod Hosting responsibilities in an equitable manner by rotating once a month or bimonthly. Students of all abilities and support needs are encouraged to reach out.

<u>Learning Pod – Full Day</u> - \$1850 / month per student (4 – 6 students) 6 hours per day (8:00 am – 2:00 pm or 9:00 am – 3:00 pm) 4 days per week (M, T, Th, F)

Learning Pod – Half Day - \$925 / month per student (4 – 6 students) **3 hours per day** (8:00 – 11:00 am or 12 noon – 3:00 pm) **4 days per week** (M, T, Th, F)

Calendar: 2020-21 School District Calendar from September 3, 2020 through June 22, 2021

Learning Pods follow school district calendar* for school days, holidays and breaks. Learning Pods starting after September will simply start at time of enrollment and continue with the school calendar until the end of the school year. *Note: Learning Pods will be in session on school district PPD days, even though these are non-student days.

Covid-19 Safe Measures: Learning Pods meet "in person" and practice social distancing, mask wearing and follow CDC guidelines for COVID-19, including daily temperature checks with non-touch infrared digital thermometer, daily health screening questionaire, and CDC-guided cleaning and disinfecting before and after each session.
