
PORTFOLIO PERFORMANCE SUMMARY

AS OF JUNE 30, 2022

\$5.3M available in the portfolio to serve as a backstop for unexpected financial issues and secure the future of The Arc of King County

The portfolio is down 14% YTD over 2021 due to stock market declines and inflationary trends.

The investment portfolio generates approximately \$140,000 in annual dividends and interest
