What We Do:

The Northwest Justice Project (NJP) King County Guardianship Clinic provides free legal assistance for low-income individuals and families who have family members with developmental disabilities and special health care needs (you must qualify as low-income in order to receive assistance).

Assistance is restricted to uncontested adult guardianships.

Eligible clients will be able to meet with a legal advocate during an appointment lasting 1-2 hours. The legal advocate will assess whether guardianship is appropriate and determine the level of service to provide.

Language and cultural support available.

DATE/TIME

Clients are seen by **confirmed appointment** only. Appointments are scheduled for the second Wednesday of every month. NJP will screen potential clients for eligibility. NJP will schedule appointments for eligible clients and provide certified interpreters (if necessary). Appointments will be scheduled for the next available opening on a monthly basis.
