

Individualized Transitional Guidance

Fall Business Group: Creator Space

<u>Description</u>: This group is an extension of our pilot summer program. Group members will create their own business. They will choose the business, research costs, budget, raise funds, find markets, advertise and sell their projects. All members in the group will gain real life work skills by creating their own business. In addition, the group will focus on communication, teamwork, collaboration, and flexibility. Our group for the fall will be creating projects for sale in a worker space and will learn how to use the different tools involved in the creation of their own projects that they will build and sell.

Concepts and Skills Covered:

- Creating an Executing a Business Plan
- Budgeting / Planning
- Advertising / Social Media Skills
- Learning Woodworking, 3 D Printing, and Other Skills
- Working as a Team
- Real Job Experience

<u>Length</u>: The group will run from October 1st - December. 12th. There will be a one week break from November 18th - 27th. The group will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12:00 to 4:00

<u>Cost</u>: Cost will be \$150 per week for 10 weeks for a total of \$1,500. If choosing to use respite this will be 8 hours of respite per week or 80 total for the whole program.

<u>Transportation</u>: We can coordinate drop offs and pickups, but it needs to be close to the location.
