Northwest's Child: Day Program for Children, Teens & Adults with moderate to severe Special needs & disabilities

Northwest's Child is a non-profit, care program for school aged children and youth with moderate to severe developmental, physical and multiple disabilities. Our students range in age from 5 to 21 yrs. **Aaron's Place** is our adult day program that serves students from age 21 years old & up with moderate to severe developmental, physical and multiple disabilities.



Northwest's Child is located in Seattle and Edmonds. Aaron's Place is located in Seattle, Kirkland, Shoreline, Mill Creek and serves students from all corners of two counties. Students can be transported by ACCESS or DART bus to our program after school or at the start of their day.



Our students, many of whom have challenges such as Cerebral Palsy, Downs Syndrome or Autism, work with our head Teachers & assistants each day on a variety of skill areas. We focus on vocational training, independent living, social/emotional skills and community integration. Our program runs 12 months a year, 5 days a week. We operate a full day summer program as well as full days on "school out" days throughout the school year and full days for our adults.
