LATINX FAMILIES OF YOUTH WITH AUTISM



Researchers are conducting a study to better understand what supports and concerns Latinx family members have about their child with autism's post-school outcomes in employment, education/ training after high school, and independence/ responsibilities. The study is two parts, a survey and a 60-minute interview.

To qualify:

- Must be a family member of a person with autism from Latinx or Hispanic background
- Family member must be over the age of 18
- Youth of the family member must be in middle school (4th through 8th grade), high school (8th to 12th grade), or a recent high school graduate (graduated within 1-3 years)
