

## REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE SERVICES IN KING COUNTY

What is a Representative Payee? A payee is a service that provides monthly financial management for individuals who may struggle to maintain their finances, pay bills, and manage a budget. Typically, this service is helpful for individuals who have a fixed monthly income (ABD, SSI, SSDI, SSA). When they receive their monthly benefits, a payee will pay the individual's monthly bills and other expenses in addition to providing weekly or bi-weekly allowances to the individual, based on an agreed upon budget. Payee services offer a participant-directed service for money management, ultimately working to try to help beneficiaries regain the ability to manage their finances.
