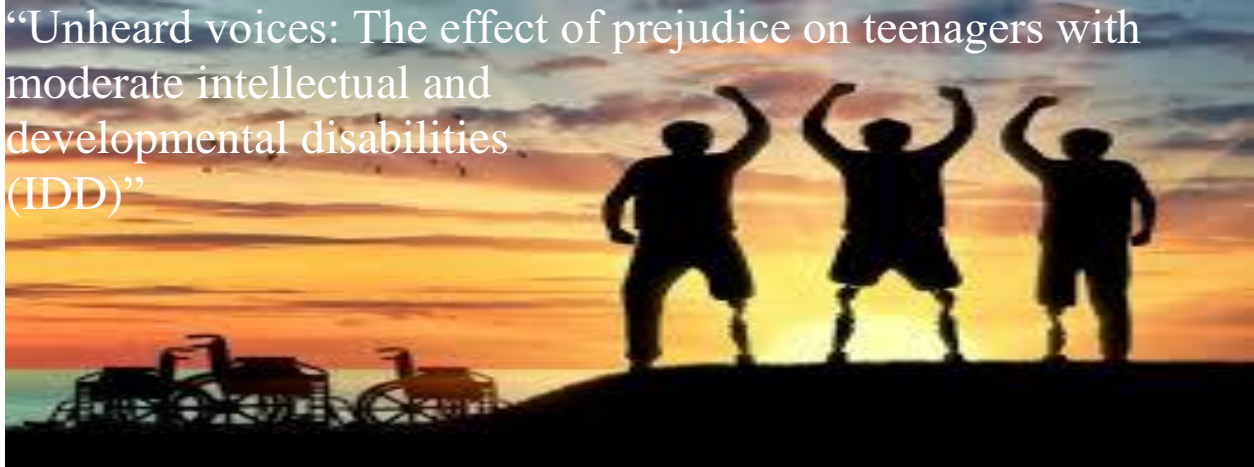


“Unheard voices: The effect of prejudice on teenagers with moderate intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD)”

Volunteers must meet these criteria:

- A parent or legal guardian of a teenager aged 13-18 is diagnosed with moderate IDD.
